COVID-19: CANTEEN STALL ASSISTANT AT BUKIT TIMAH CAMPUS AMONG COMMUNITY CASES IN SINGAPORE

Dear Colleagues and Students

- We would like to inform you that an individual who works part-time as a stall assistant at The Summit canteen at Bukit Timah Campus has tested positive for COVID-19 on 27 April 2021. The individual, who is employed by the stall vendor and is not a staff of NUS, helps out periodically at the canteen stall.
- 2. The individual is currently receiving medical treatment and is doing well. We wish the individual a speedy recovery.
- 3. Deep cleaning and disinfection have already been carried out at the stall where the individual was working, and also the entire canteen. The canteen is currently closed until further notice.
- 4. All individuals who are identified as close contacts have been issued with Quarantine Orders.
- 5. As a precautionary measure, anyone who had been to The Summit canteen at Bukit Timah Campus at the following dates and times below should monitor their health closely for 14 days from their date of visit. They should see a doctor promptly if they develop symptoms of acute respiratory infection (such as cough, sore throat and runny nose), as well as fever and loss of taste or smell, and inform the doctor of their exposure history.
 - 15 April 2021: 0730h to 1540h
 - 19 April 2021: 0730h to 1550h
 - 22 April 2021: 0730h to 1540h
 - 27 April 2021: 0720h to 0940h
- 6. Your health and safety are of the highest priority. Please continue to observe all safe management measures on our campuses, which include safe distancing, wearing of masks at all times, declaration of temperature through uNivUS, and the use of TraceTogether and NUSafe app. If you are unwell, please exercise social responsibility and see a doctor immediately.
