COVID-19: CLEANER WORKING AT GOVERNMENT QUARANTINE FACILITY LOCATED AT PRINCE GEORGE'S PARK RESIDENCES AMONG COMMUNITY CASES IN SINGAPORE

Dear Colleagues and Students

1. We would like to inform you that an individual, who works as a cleaner at the Government Quarantine Facility (GQF) located at Prince George's Park Residences (PGPR), has tested positive for COVID-19 on 24 June 2021.
2. The individual, who is employed by an external vendor, works alone to clean Block 6, the designated GQF at PGPR. This block has been unoccupied since 13 May 2021. The individual was last at work at the GQF on 21 June 2021 and did not interact with any NUS staff or students. Contact tracing is underway and thus far, no NUS staff or students have been identified as close contacts.
3. Deep cleaning and disinfection have already been carried out at the affected facilities and common areas.
4. The individual is currently receiving medical treatment and is doing well. We wish the individual a speedy recovery.
5. Your health and safety are of the highest priority. Please continue to observe all safe management measures on our campuses, which include safe distancing, wearing of masks at all times, declaration of temperature through uNivUS, and the use of both TraceTogether and NUSafe app. If you are unwell, please be socially responsible and see a doctor immediately.
