**COVID-19: #ResilientNUS PLEDGE**

Dear Colleagues and Students

1. As Singapore moves towards COVID-19 resilience, we must remain vigilant and do our part to protect ourselves and our community. With the rise in COVID-19 community cases, student leaders from our Halls of Residence and Residential Colleges have spearheaded a ground-up initiative to urge their respective communities to be socially responsible across our campuses.
2. In solidarity with this effort and incorporating ideas as well as inputs from our student leaders, NUS has developed a **Statement of Commitment** for us to affirm as a community that we will:

- I will be vigilant in masking up, observe personal hygiene and comply with safe management measures, including updating my vaccination status and weekly test results.
- I pledge to do my part in protecting the NUS community, so that together we can work towards a stronger NUS and achieve an enriching and meaningful university life.

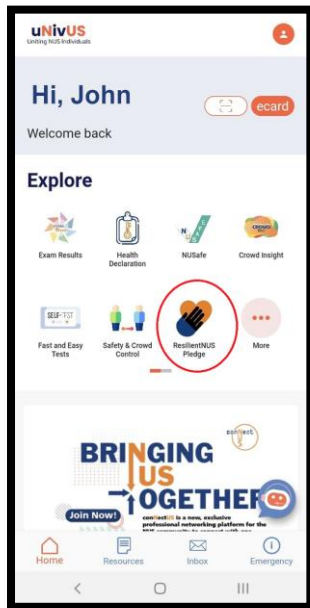
